

2026 Ministry Budget Preparations, Discussions, and Decisions

Our church's committee leaders and staff are in the process of preparing a plan to fund our 2026 ministry budget. There has been much discussion this year about what we want our ministries to look like, so many voices are involved in our planning.

Once the Finance Committee finalizes the proposed 2026 ministry budget, we will mail a letter in mid-October to every household that will include a one-page summary of the financial plan. This also includes a comparative summary of the 2025 and 2026 ministry budgets so that everyone can see where adjustments are proposed.

Please note that our Finance Committee will present and guide discussion around the 2026 plan during the congregational meeting on Sunday, October 26 immediately after worship. At this time, the church will be asked to vote on whether or not to approve the ministry budget.

Please pray that everyone involved in this process will be open to listening to the Holy Spirit's direction, and also prayerfully consider your commitment to support Second Baptist in 2026!

Young Adults (room 118) - Amy Cook, Jim and Catherine Lewis, teachers


Around the Bible in 80 Days



Ms. Roz Learning Playdate





This led to certification as a Level One arboretum by the Tennessee Urban Forestry Council. As the weather becomes more pleasant this month, take a stroll around our campus to learn more about the diversity



of God's creation. Black metal signs are nailed about eye level on selected trees. Look for them on the north sides, where they're protected from fading by the sun. Nails are driven only half-way to accommodate tree growth. Soon we will have booklets available in the foyer with a map and facts about the trees. We look forward to notifying area teachers about this resource and giving guided tours to groups, another way Second Baptist can extend hospitality to our neighbors.
